### Participant Competitions

June 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024

#### Flintlock Muzzleloader Shooting Competition

1. Flintlock Rifle and Smoothbore only. Any firearm with a fixed rear sight will shoot in the Rifle competition.
2. Shooting Range will be open for the competition from 10:30 am to 2:30 pm Saturday ONLY.
3. Entry fee is a \$20 blanket prize per participant. If you plan on shooting both Rifle and Smoothbore, you will need 2 blanket prizes.
4. Each of the Rifle and Smoothbore shoots will consist of a minimum of 15 shots.
5. Single round ball only.
6. Guns shall only be loaded at the range under supervision of shooting competition host. **DO NOT** transport a loaded firearm to or from your vehicle or camp to the range.
7. Safety glasses and hearing protection are encouraged.
8. Competition instructions and any additional safety guidelines will be posted at the range.
9. Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) shooters for Rifle and Smoothbore, 6 prizes total, the prizes will be on display at the range throughout the competition. Please consult the competition host for prize giveaway time and location.

#### Tomahawk and Knife Throwing Competition

1. The Tomahawk and Knife Throwing Competition will be open from 12:00 pm (noon) until 2:00 pm both Saturday and Sunday.
2. Competition consists of three (3) throws each with a Tomahawk and a Knife. One (1) point for each 'stick', two (2) points for each cut of a single rubber band and three (3) points for each cut of both rubber bands.
3. There will be a limited number of Tomahawks and Knives to use at the range. Please bring your own though if you have them.
4. Prizes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place competitors at the Tomahawk and Knife Throwing Area around 2:30 pm Sunday afternoon.

#### Primitive Archery Competition

1. The Primitive Archery Competition will be open from 10:00 am until 12:00 pm (noon) both Saturday and Sunday.
2. Primitive style long bows only.
3. Competition rules and instructions will be provided by the competition host upon arrival at the Archery Range.
4. Prizes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place competitors at the Archery Range around 2:00 pm Sunday afternoon.

All event rules apply to the above Competitions. All Competitions are open to registered participants only.
